Safety Recommendations

We at the Saskatoon Food Bank & Learning Centre recognize that there may be safety concerns when contemplating hosting a food drive this year. With the spread of COVID-19 we want to ensure that all participants are taking precautions to maintain the health and safety of everyone involved.

While hosting your food drive we recommend the following measures that are in alignment with the guidelines from the Saskatchewan Health Authority:

- Wearing a mask
- Keeping six feet/2 meters of distance between people
- Washing your hands thoroughly and often

In addition to the measures listed above, we would also recommend that once a donation has been placed into the food barrel it not be touched again. If a food barrel becomes full before the scheduled pickup date we can easily arrange to have it swapped with a new one.
